

1. INTRODUCTION

The INSARAG IEC/R Leadership Course is designed to improve the quality and standard of the INSARAG External Classification and Reclassification process, including the methodology used for implementation. The course is delivered to improve the performance consistency of Classification Team Leaders, Deputy Team Leaders, Mentors and INSARAG Secretariat Representatives to ensure the INSARAG Minimum Standard is measured objectively and equally for teams undergoing the IEC/R process.

2. COURSE AIM

The course aim is to ensure consistency of the IEC/R Process. The course objectives are:

- To ensure complete understanding of the INSARAG methodology in relation to the IEC/R process
- Achieving an objective approach to the IEC/R Process
- Defining the coordination structure between all stakeholders
- Providing an open forum to discuss lessons learnt (positive and negative) during previous IEC/R processes
- Providing an opportunity to network and take advantage of “mutual learning”
- Understanding of UC methodology requirements of the Checklist

3. TARGET AUDIENCE and PARTICIPANT PRE REQUISITES

Maximum of 24 participants per course.

All participants must have a full working knowledge of the INSARAG Guidelines, Volume II, Manual C, OSOCC Online Course.

This training course is a pre-requisite to be considered for the position of Classification Team Leader, Deputy Team Leader, Mentor, or INSARAG Secretariat representatives.

4. METHODOLOGY

The course methodology is derived from INSARAG Guidelines, particularly Volume II, Manual C and will take participants chronologically through the entire IEC/R process, to provide clarity and a common understanding of the process.
