### Medical Working Group

- Suggested changes in Vol. I (4.3 regarding request to practice USAR medicine), possibly Vol. II Man. A (volume is newly written by NCBWG; include MWG changes accordingly), Vol. II Man. B (changes in wording), Vol. II Man. C (XXX), Vol. III (to be only about IEC/R handbook)
- Adaptations in Check-list (sits with IEC/R WG)
  - Additional requirements aiming at more medical specific exercise settings (requiring total of 5 medical scenarios for an IEC/R)
  - Clarification for: hot cutting (consider technology development), confined spaces (definition), lifting (hydraulic/pneumatic), keeping contact with victims <u>during</u> a rescue

- Funding a major issue (several changes/items connected to that)
- Question if one single glossary for all volumes, not each volume separately
- Vol. II Man. B: include IMWG tasks (establishing ICMS for use, facilitate help desk
